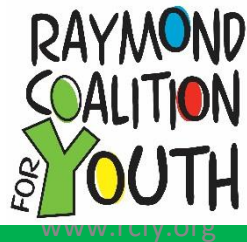

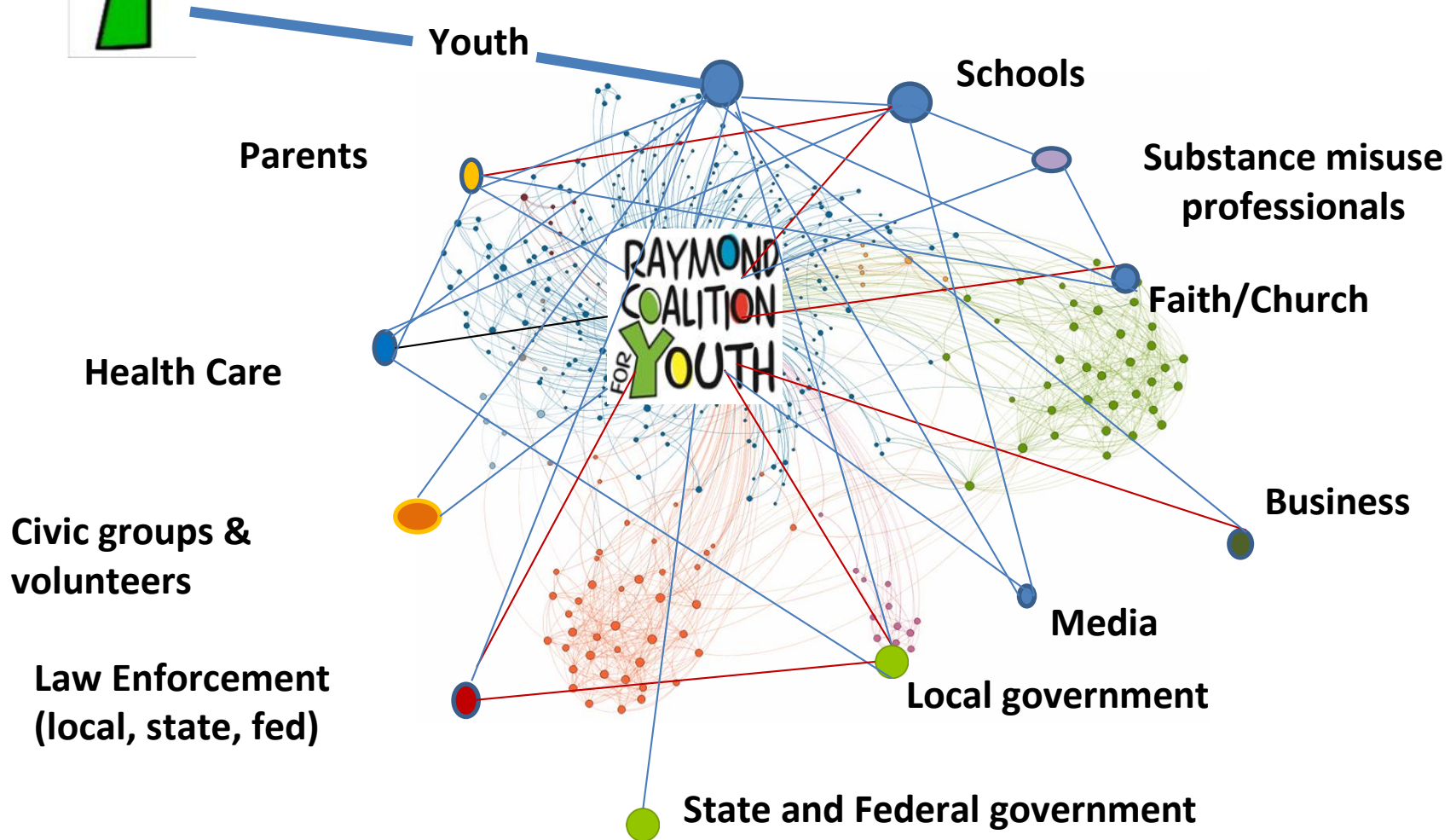


What is a coalition?

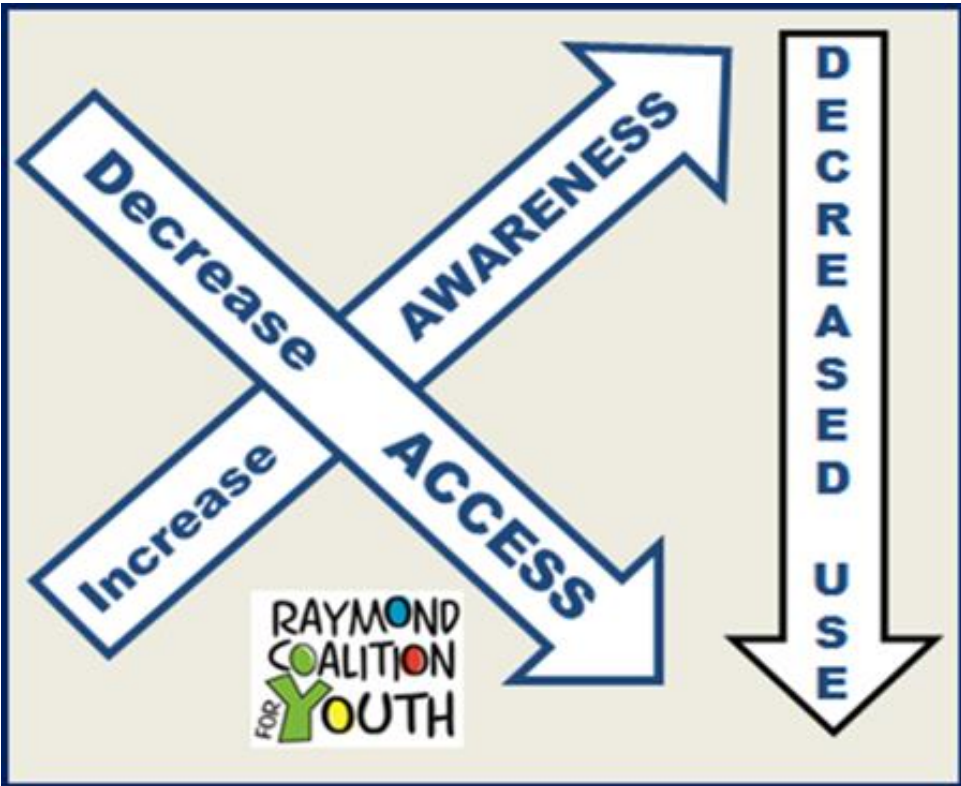

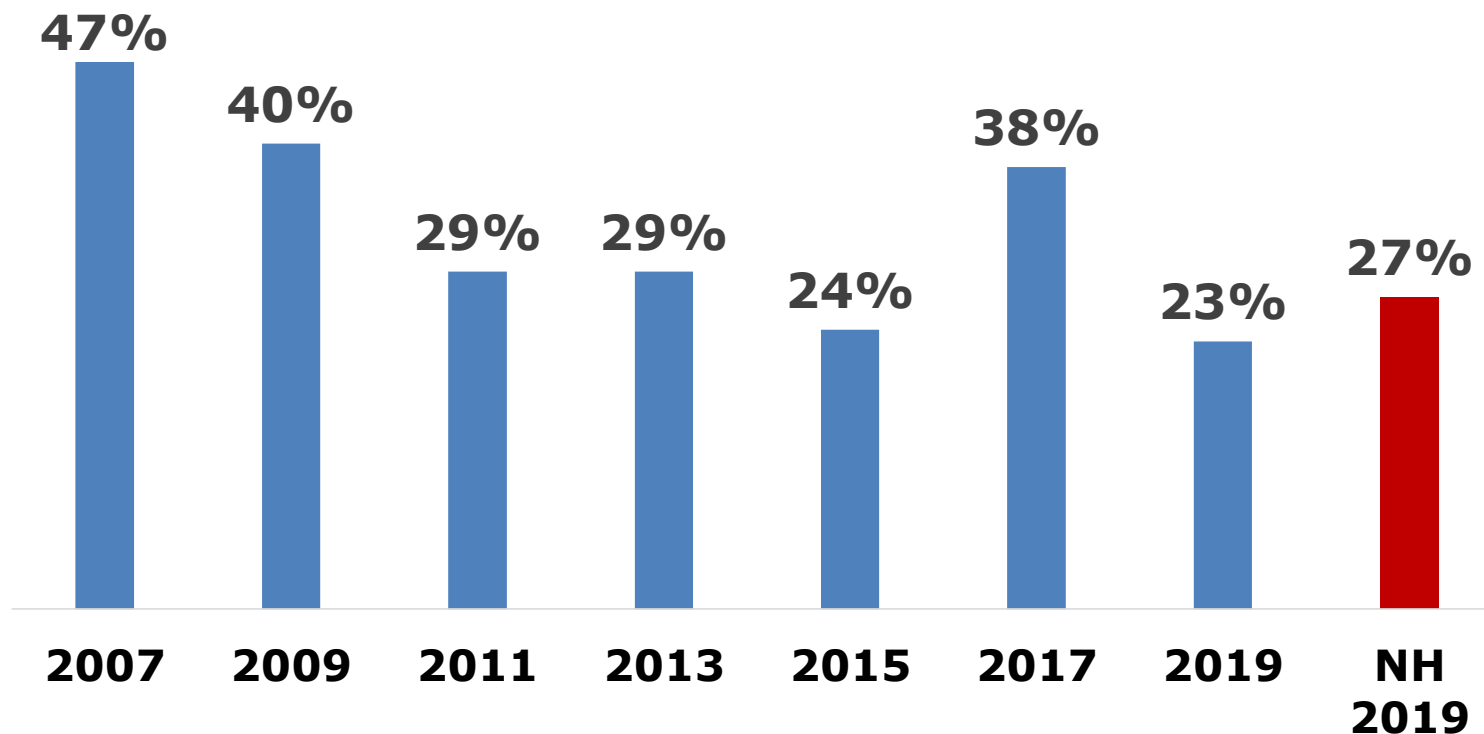

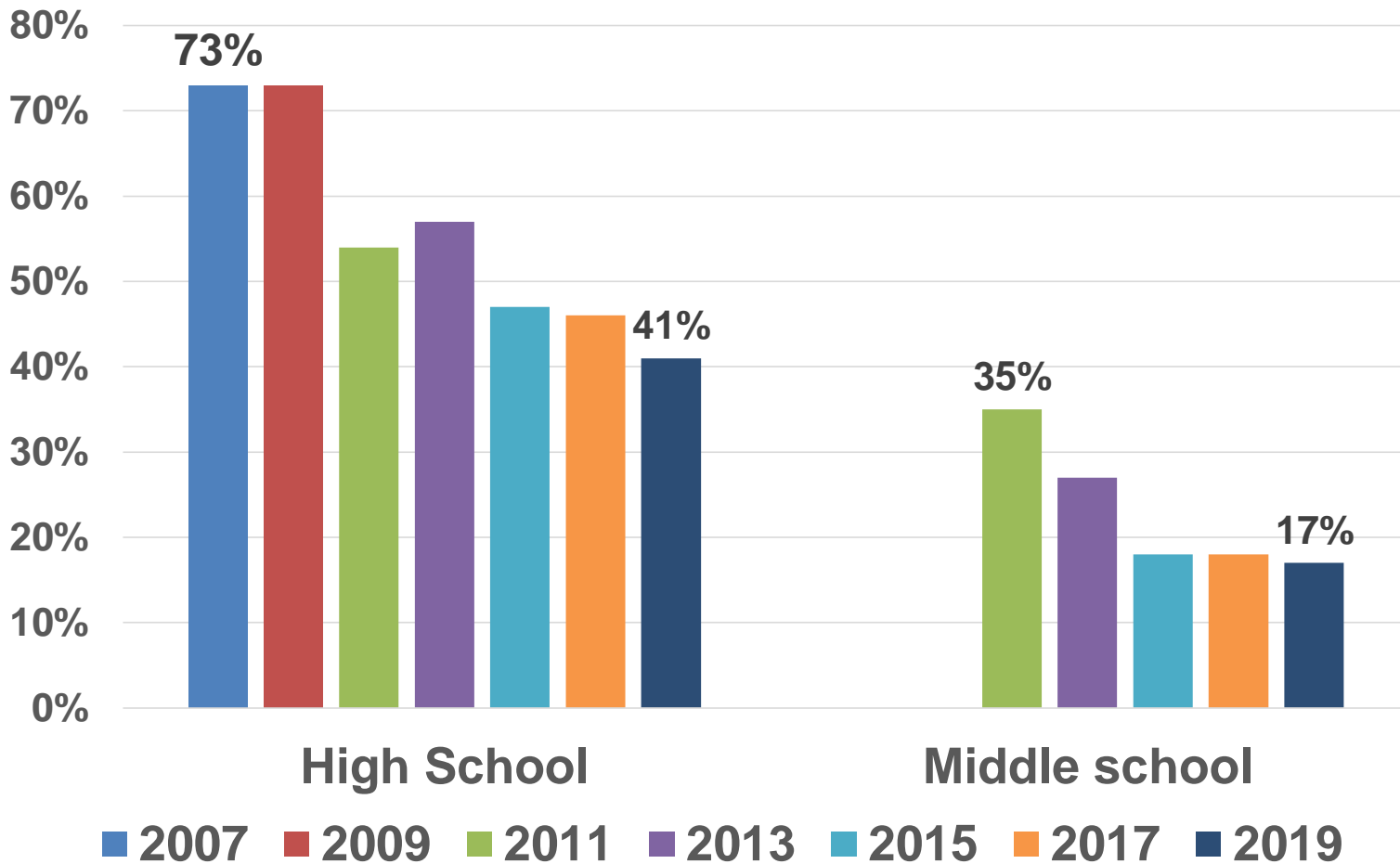


Past 30 day use – Alcohol

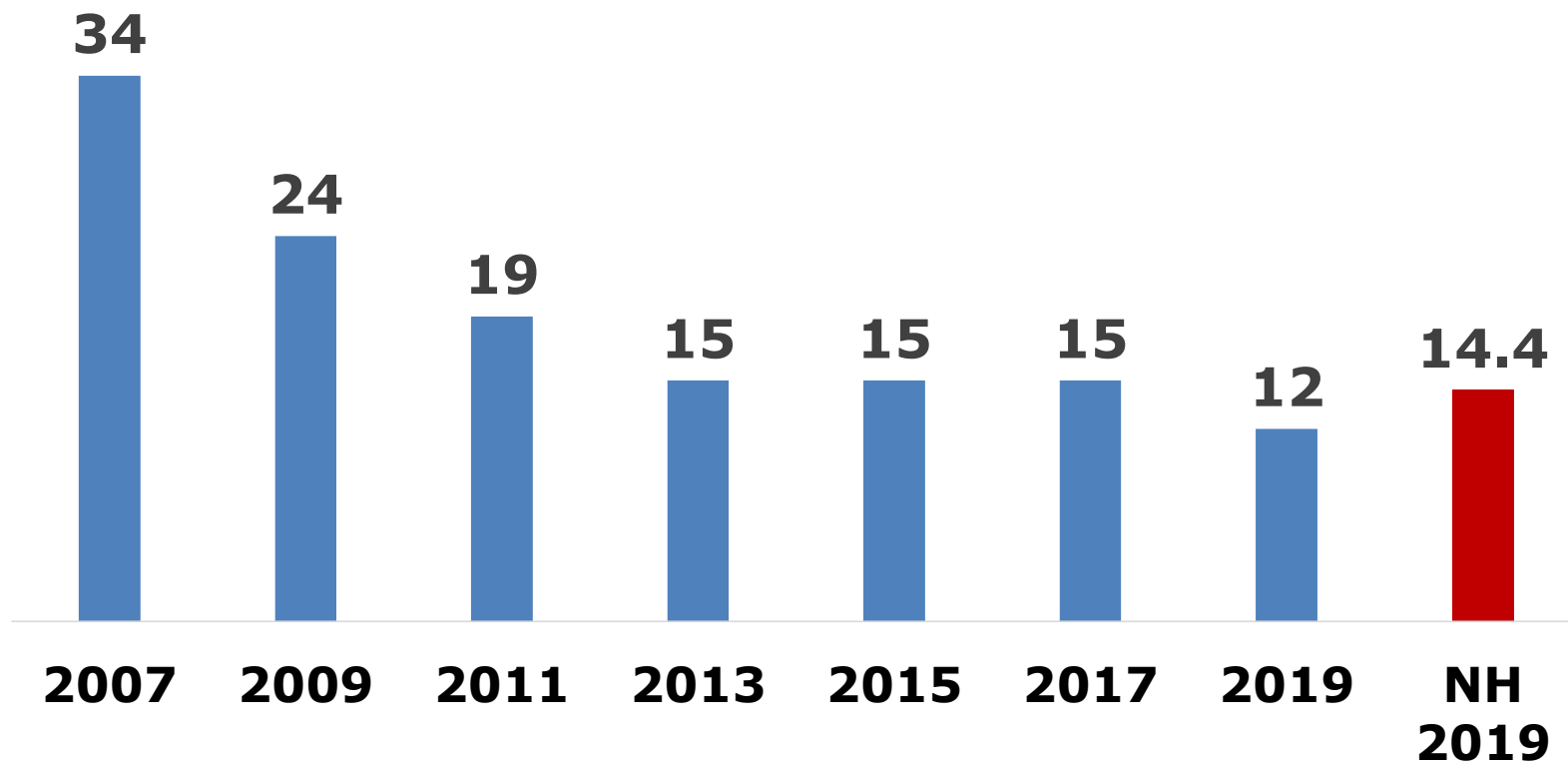


Life time use - Alcohol



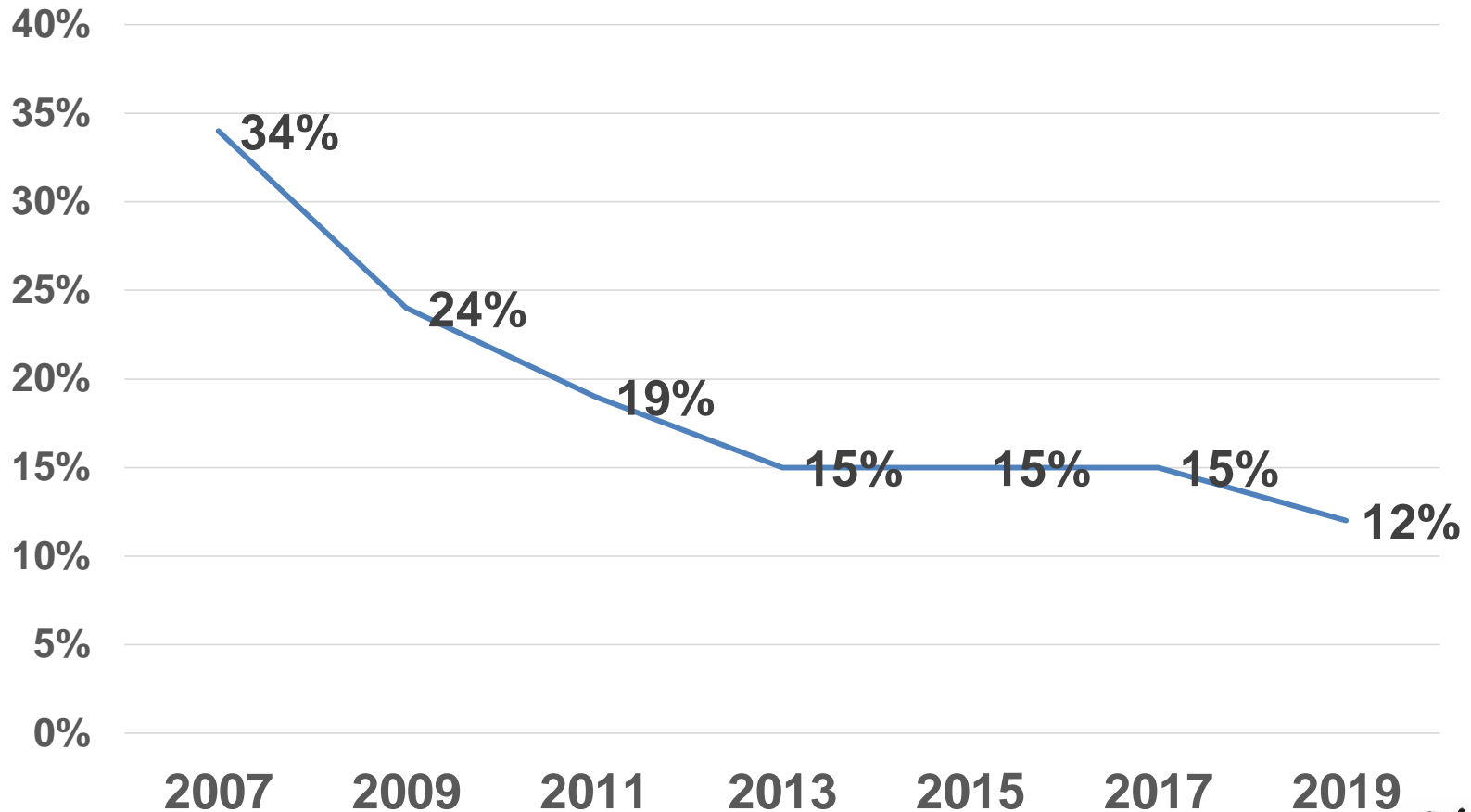
Binge Drinking, 5 + drinks in one sitting

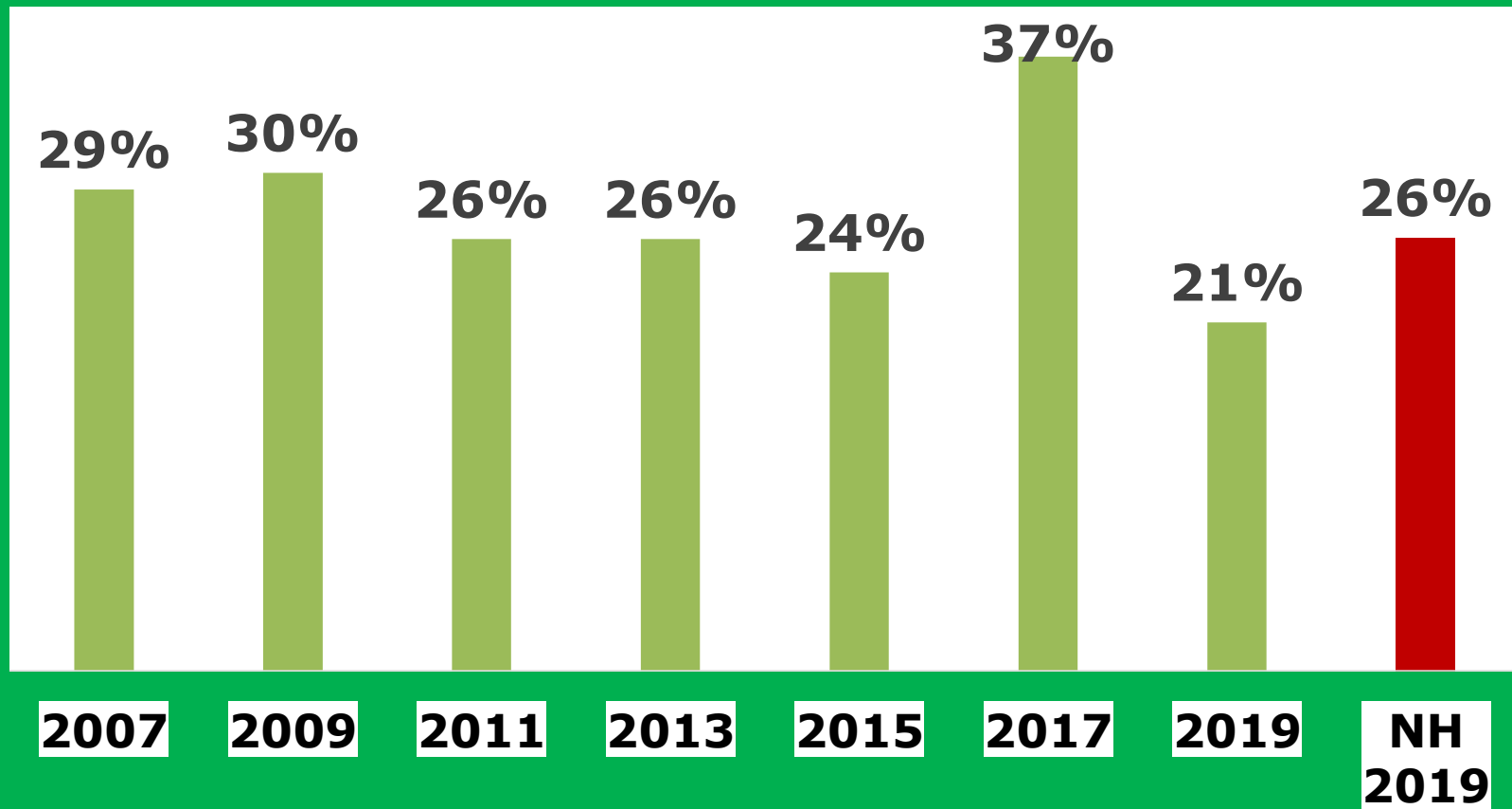
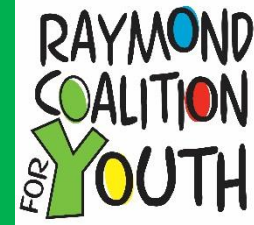

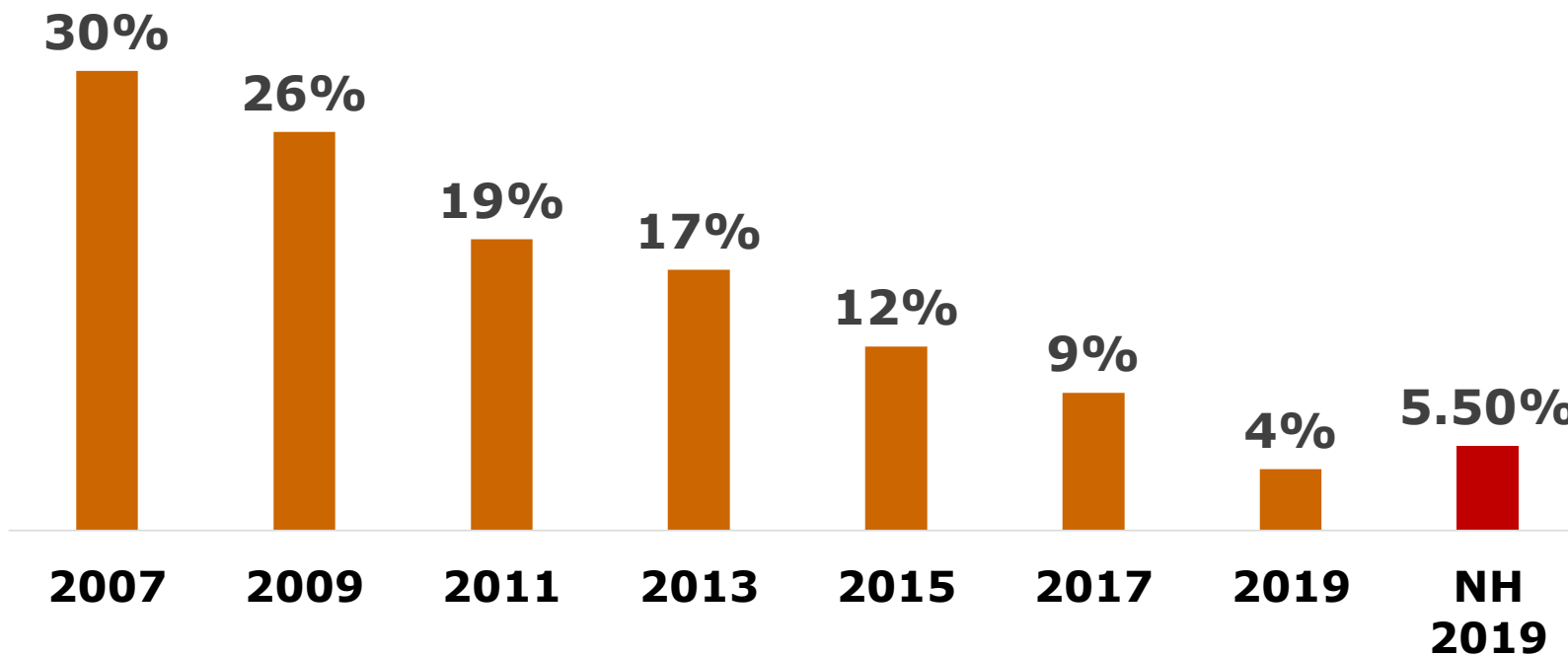


Past 30 day – Marijuana use Raymond High – State of NH

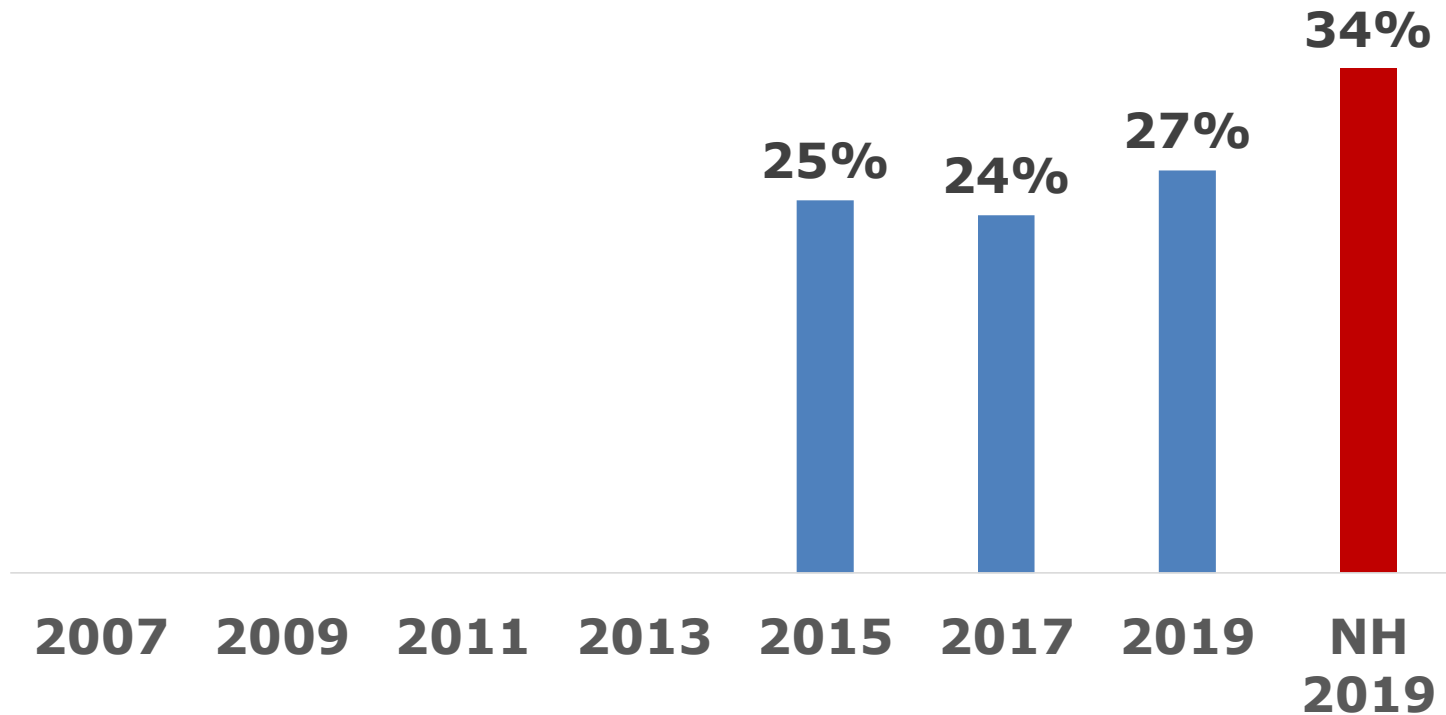
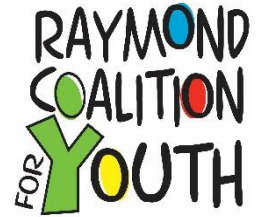


Past 30 day - Cigarette and Raymond High – State of NH

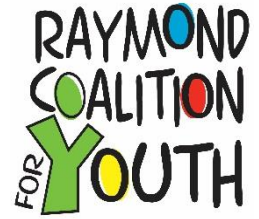

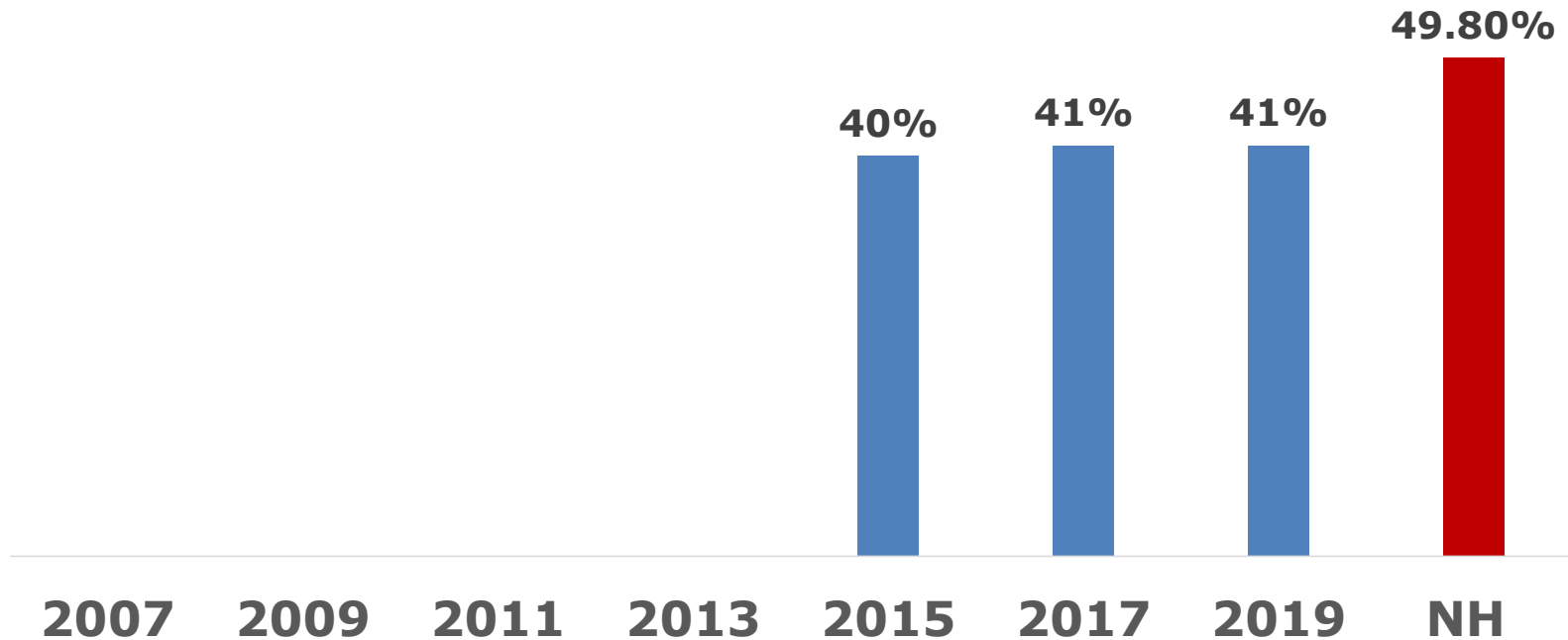
Past 30 day - Electronic Vapor Use Raymond High – State of NH



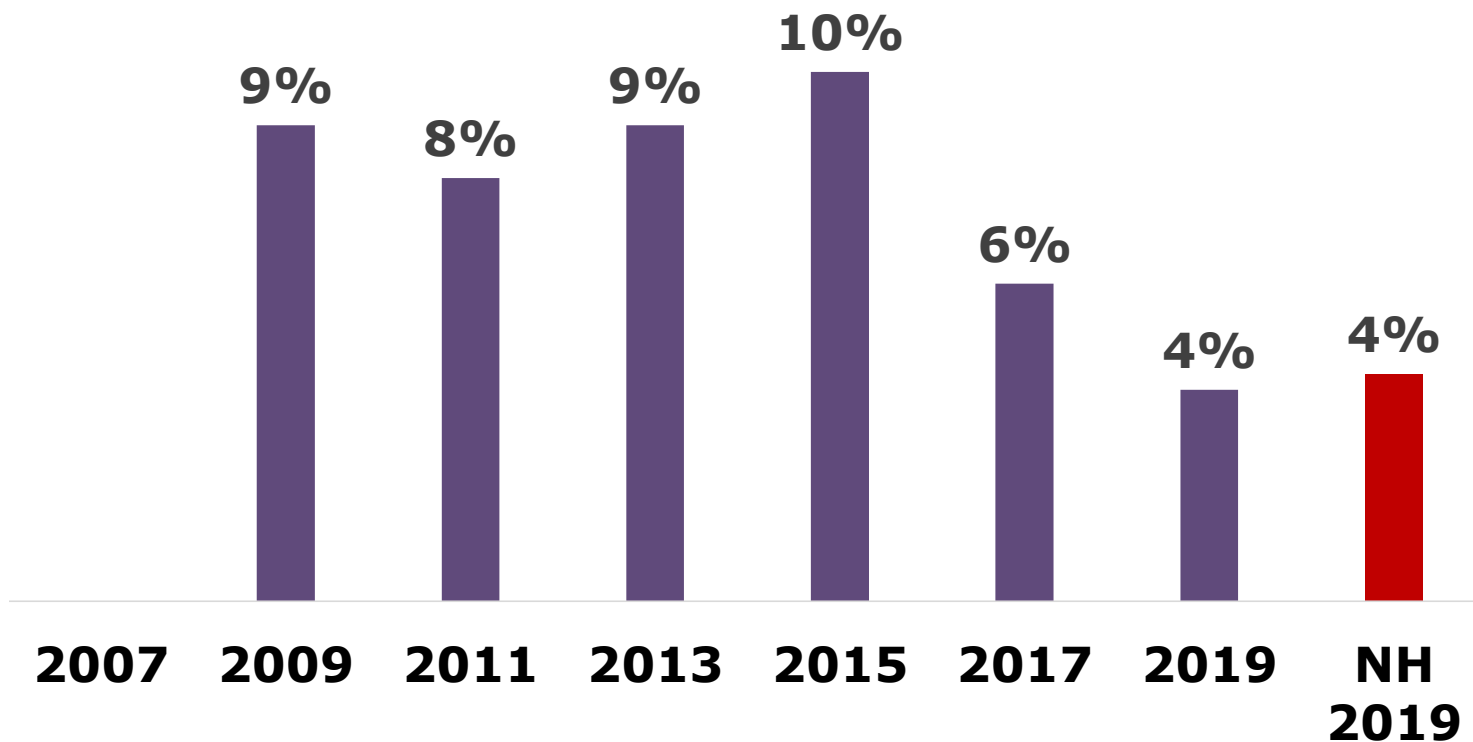
Students who have ever USED Electronic Vape



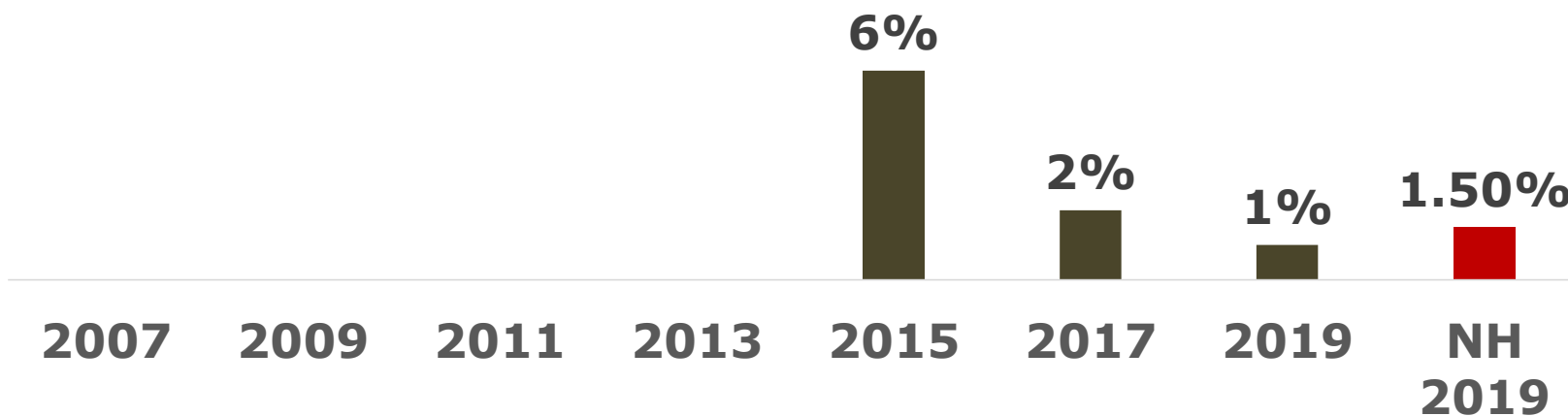

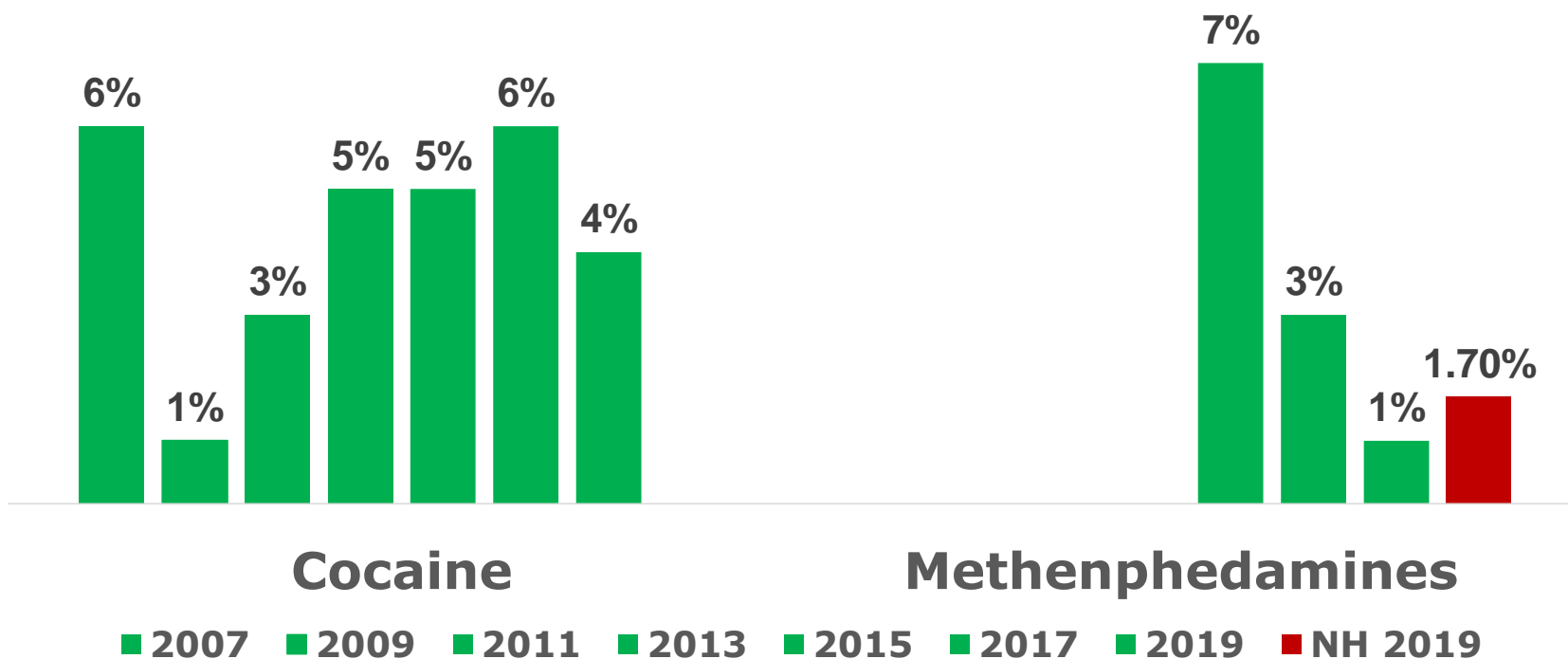
Past 30 day - Prescription Drug Misuse Raymond High – State of NH



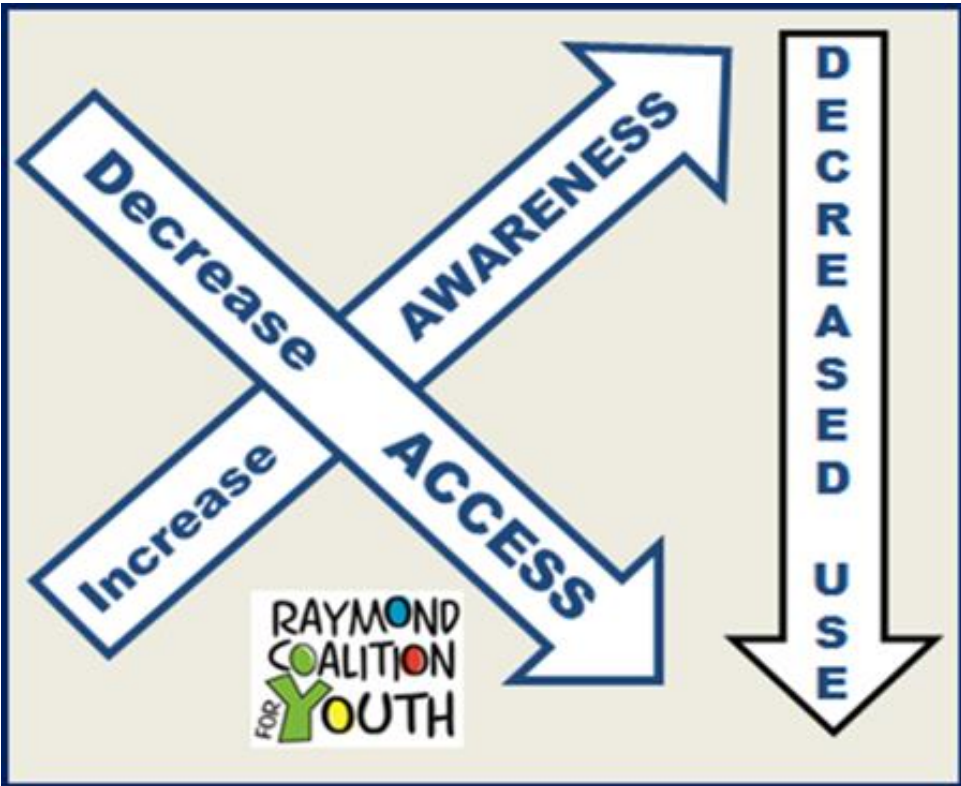
Past 30 day - Heroin/Opioid Raymond High – State of NH

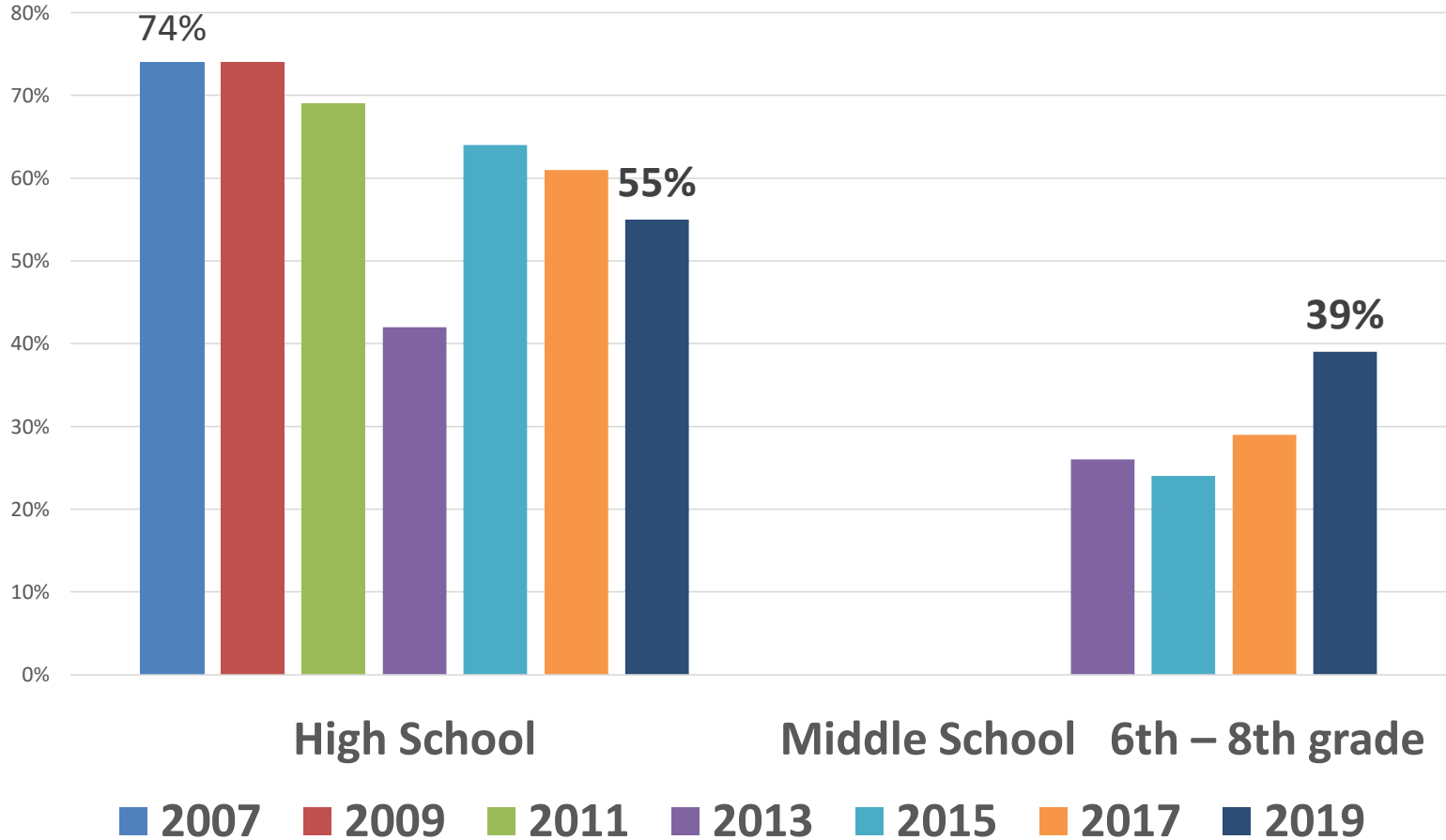

Of students had at least one parent who talked with them about the dangers of tobacco, alcohol, or drug use during the past 12 months.

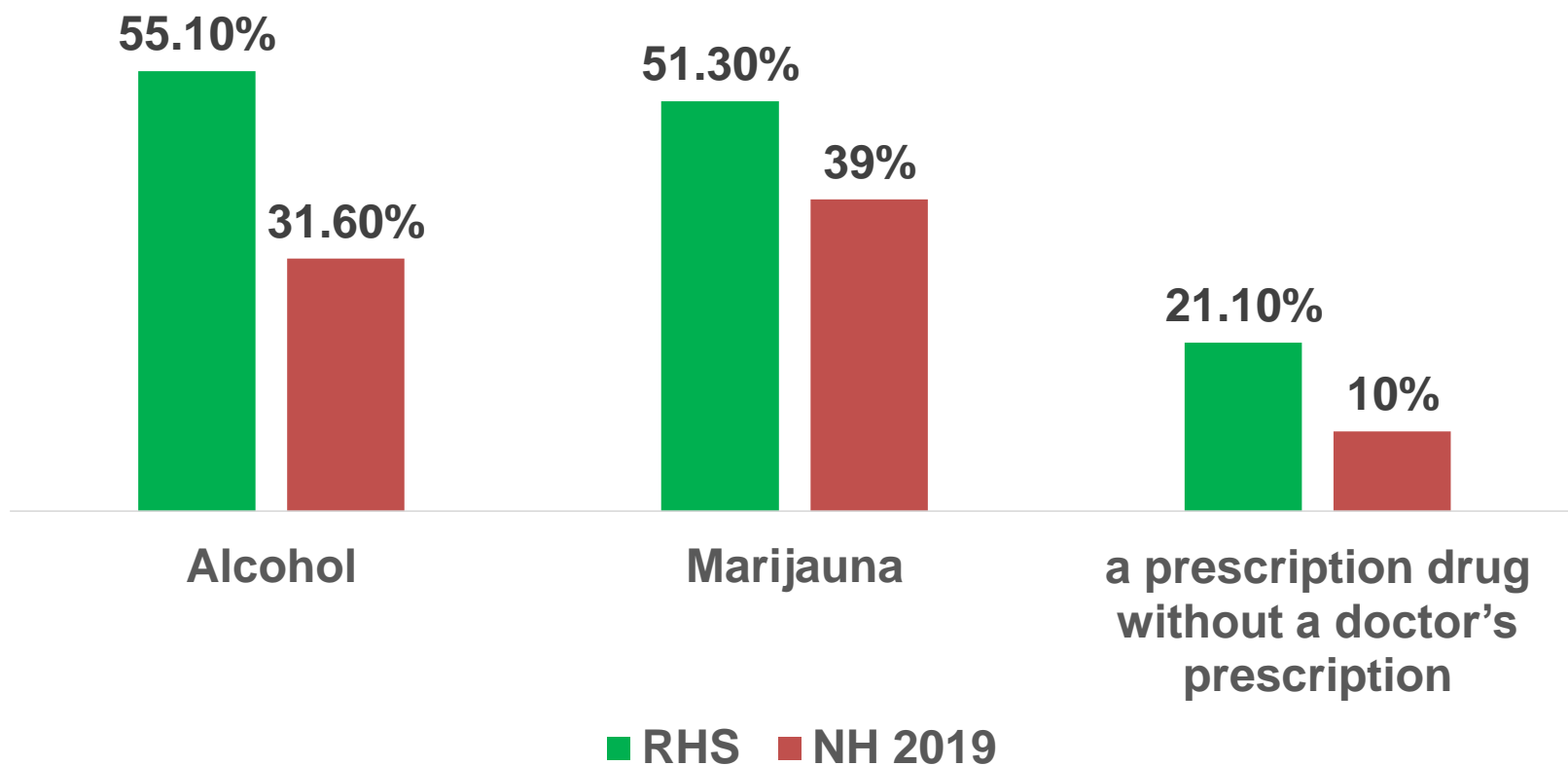
78.1%

Of students agree or strongly agree that parents or other adults in the family have clear rules and consequences for their behavior.

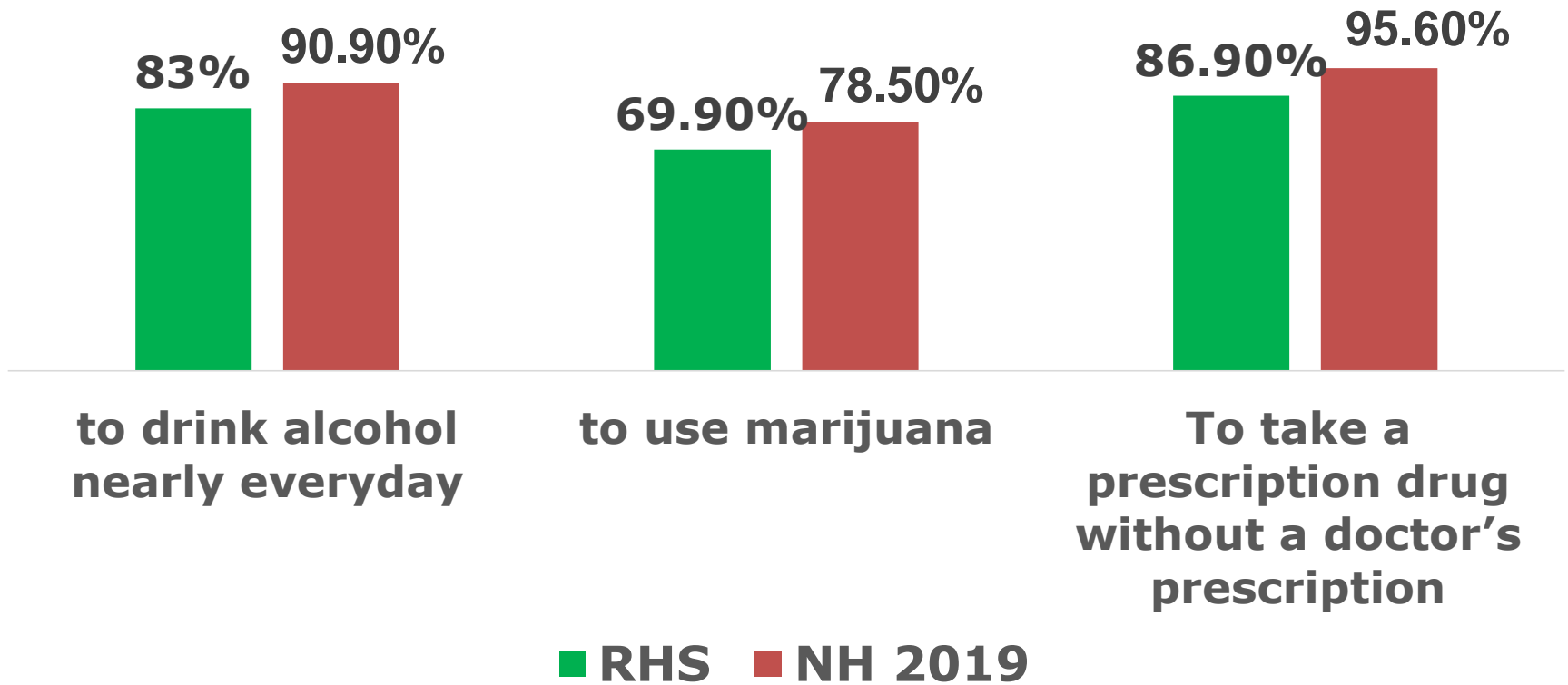
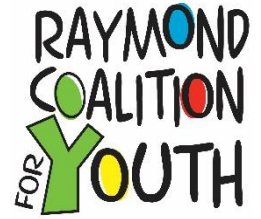

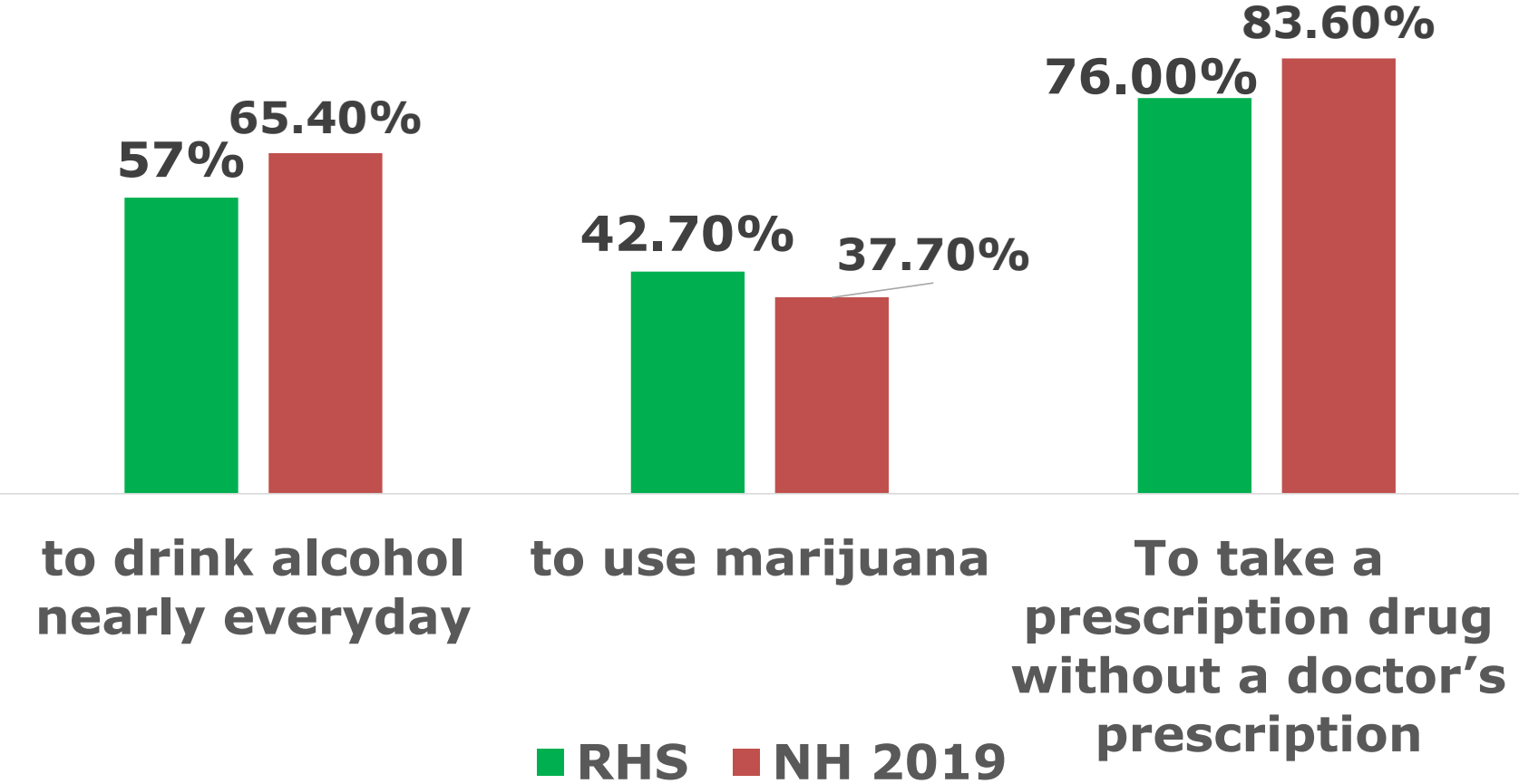
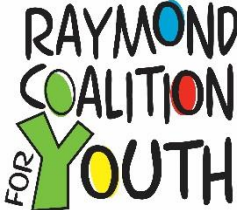
Students who think it would be easy or very easy to get
