Today's meeting focused on the results of the YRBS survey given to students in 6th to 12th grade. Approximately 300-350 High School students and 200 Middle School students. The results were given by Aimee Delaney, PH.D who is the evaluator for RCFY and works from Worcester State University in Worcester, MA.

She reported on past 30 day use in the following categories: Cigarettes, Vaping, Alcohol, Marijuana, Vaping Marijuana, RX use, Huffing and Heroin.

She then reported on the Risk Factors of riding and driving with others using alcohol and marijuana, texting and phone use.

Dr. Delaney will return in January to report on other results such as suicide, Mental health, interpersonal relationships and bullying.
